WHAT'S YOUR NEXT STEP?

NEW IDENTITY

The Bible, in 2 Corinthians 5:17 tells us that we are a "new creation" when we get saved. This reminds us that being saved, following Jesus is a brand new start. If we are new, then there should be some differences and changes in us.

Remember, following Jesus is a journey. Immediately God calls you His child and gives you His Spirit that lives with you to help us live the life Jesus is calling us to live.

READ GOD'S WORD

SERVE

We can follow Jesus in many ways. 1 Corinthians 12 explains that those of us that are part of God's family are like a body that work together. Serving is helping others to see, know and grow in Jesus Christ. Its about working together to reach people that God loves. The good news is that you can serve here. Talk to our leaders to find out how you can use the talents God has given you to serve Him.

BAPTISM

Baptism is sometimes a new concept for people or something that they aren't sure about. We have a great resource that explains more about baptism to you in a more in depth way than this card can, but still keeps it very simple. Essentially, Jesus told his followers, that's us, to be baptized and baptize others that are ready to follow Jesus.
