Paul's First Journey

Acts 13:1-3; 14:8-28

Key Passage: Acts 1:8

Christ Connection: Paul obeyed the Holy Spirit and shared the gospel with anyone who would listen. People tried to stop Paul, but Paul did not give up. Many people believed in Jesus, and the church grew. The Holy Spirit wants us to tell others about Jesus so they can be saved from their sin.

Big Picture Question and Answer: How do people hear about Jesus? God uses Christians to tell others about Jesus.

Main Point for Babies and Toddlers: Christians tell about Jesus.

Main Point for Preschoolers: The Holy Spirit sent Paul and Barnabas to tell people about Jesus.

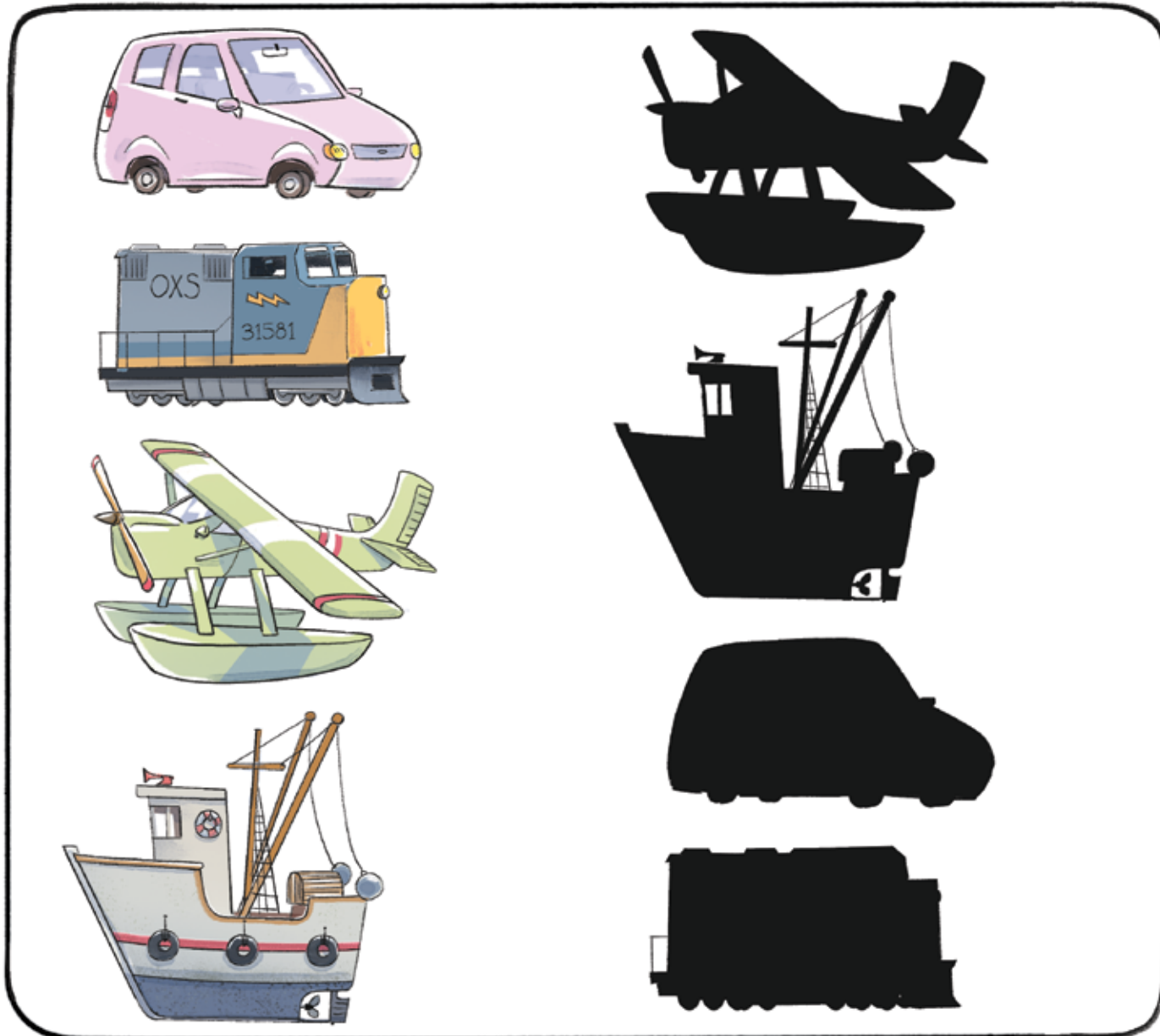
Bible Story Points:

- Visit a local hospital. Prayerwalk the halls and pray for patients who are open to it.

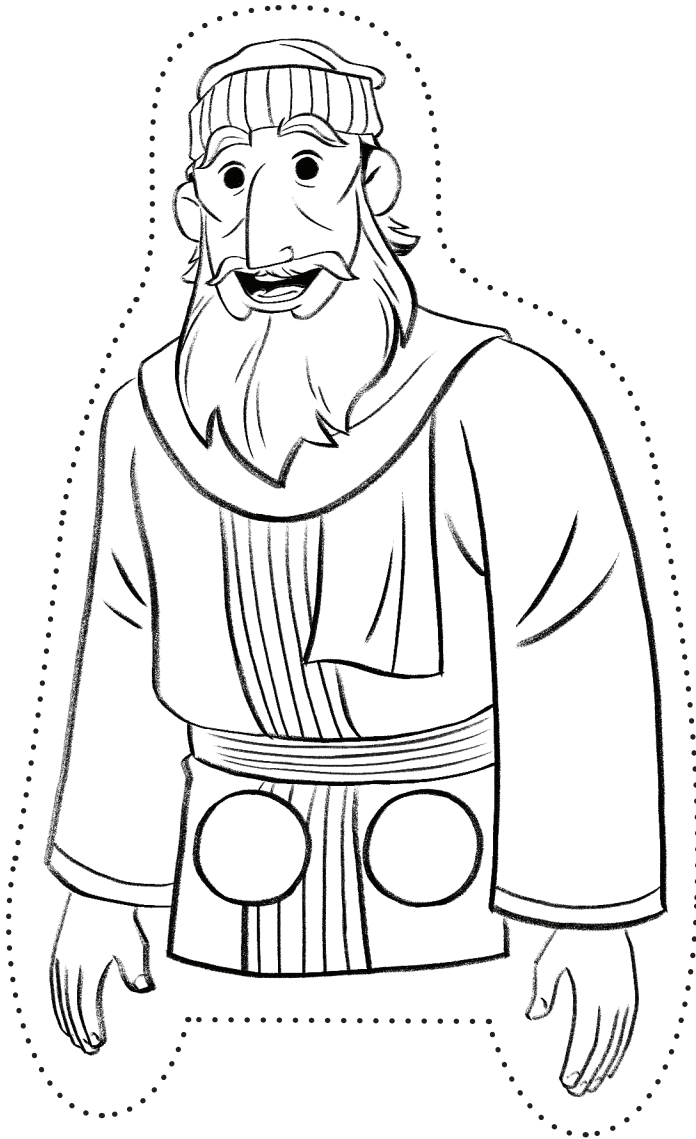
