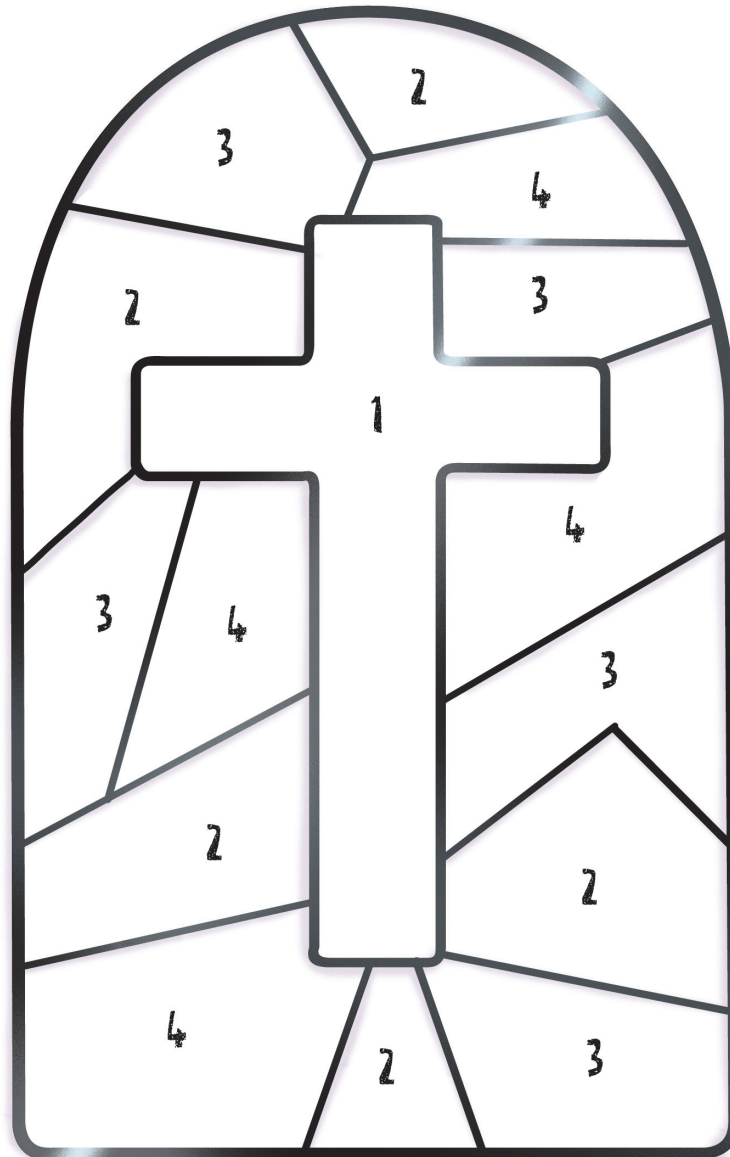
INSTRUCTIONS: Color each space the appropriate color based on the number.

Key Passage: Romans 6:9

Christ Connection: The most important thing that ever happened is that Jesus died and was raised from the dead. Jesus never did anything wrong, but He was punished because we sinned. God forgives us for sin because Jesus died for us. God raised Jesus from the dead to be King over everything.

Big Picture Question: Who saves us from our sin? Jesus saves us from sin.

Main Point for Babies and Toddlers: Jesus is alive.

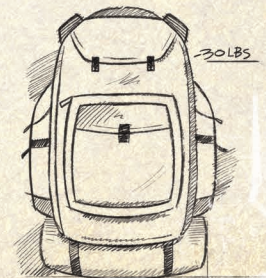
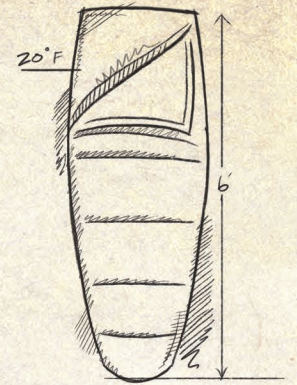
Main Point for Preschoolers: Jesus died on the cross and is alive.

- God sent Jesus to earth because He loves us.



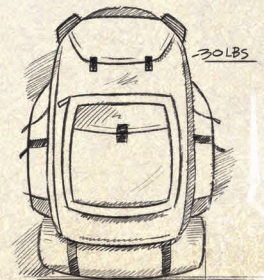
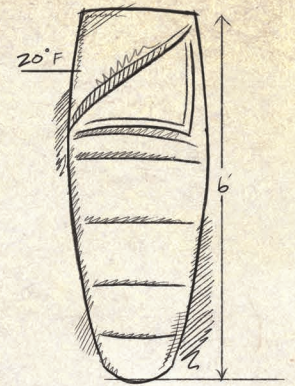
