**KEY PASSAGE:** Romans 6:9

**BIG PICTURE QUESTION:**

- Who saves us from our sin?  
Jesus saves us from sin.

**BIBLE STORY:**

**JESUS' TRIUMPHAL ENTRY**

- Jesus and His friends traveled to Jerusalem for Passover.
- People welcomed Jesus as their King.
- Jesus rode on a donkey, and the people shouted, "Hosanna."
- The religious leaders did not like the people praising Jesus.

**FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:**

- Why do you think the religious leaders were angry that the people were praising Jesus?
- *Hosanna* means "save now." Why was that a good word for the people to shout?
- Read Revelation 19:11-13,16. Compare Jesus' second coming to His triumphal entry.

**FAMILY ACTIVITY:**

- Go horseback riding as a family. Talk about how Jesus will come back one day riding on a white horse as King over everything.
- Work through a family devotional for Holy Week.

# Jesus' Triumphal Entry

Matthew 21:1-17; Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:28-44;

**Key Passage:** Romans 6:9

**Christ Connection:** The people were happy to see Jesus. They knew He was their King. Jesus came riding on a donkey, just as the prophet Zechariah said He would. (Zechariah 9:9) One day, Jesus will come back, riding on a white horse as King over everything. (Revelation 19:11)

**Big Picture Question:** Who saves us from our sin? Jesus saves us from sin.

**Main Point for Babies and Toddlers:** Jesus is alive.

**Main Point for Preschoolers:** People welcomed Jesus as their King.

**Bible Story Points:**

- Jesus is God's Son.
- God sent Jesus to earth because He loves us.
- People praised Jesus as their King.
